AIRPORT AND CRUISE TERMINAL INFORMATION

CRUISE CHECK-IN

Begins usually around 1:00 pm, depending on how the debarkation of the previous cruise goes. However, you will not be able to go to the cabins until later in the afternoon, as they will need to finish cleaning them. Usually there is an announcement on board when you can go to your cabin. You must be on board by 4:00 p.m.

PORT:

AIRPORT:

Copenhagen International Airport

Airport Code CPH – 6 miles to City Center

BUS SHUTTLE SERVICE:

Purchase of transfers from Princess can be done through Sundancer up to 10 days prior to your sail date; you will need to provide your flight information at the time of purchase. Flight details are provided to the transportation company to assist in expediting your transfer to the pier. It is your responsibility to update Sundancer with any changes to your flight schedule to ensure you are met by the transportation company.

Copenhagen - Cost of Transfers Per Person: (NOTE: Prices and times to be confirmed)

Between CPH – Copenhagen International Airport and the cruise port:

One Way: \$25 per person - Round Trip: \$50 per person

When using the cruise line Shuttle Service your flights must arrive 4-1/4 hours before cruise departure time (1:30 pm). For

Airport arrivals: a Princess Cruise Line representative will meet you in the baggage claim area for domestic flights and outside of customs for international flights to assist with transportation to the ship or hotel (if applicable).

Your departing flight should depart 2-1/2 hours after cruise arrival time. For Departures transfers: the shipboard team will advise you of the exact departure time while onboard.

All guests who purchase transfers will receive a transfer voucher with their eDocs. You can add these transfers up to two weeks prior to sailing. We return to the port about 6:00 a.m. However we have to clear customs. More details will be provided as to when you will be able to start departing the ship. It is usually about 2 hours after customs boards the ship. To be safe please use flight time guidelines above, even if using taxis.

Once Sundancer books a group hotel we will provide those shuttle options.

OTHER TRANSPORTATION OPTIONS:

Taxi (most expensive option) - Take a taxi when you're flying from Copenhagen Airport and get dropped off right at the door. Drop-off points are located directly outside Terminal 2 and Terminal 3. A pick-up point is located directly outside Terminal 3. The rate includes a tip, and it is usually possible to pay by credit card. A trip from Oceankaj/quay to Copenhagen Airport cost approx. DKK 450.00 – DKK550.00 depending on time of the day. A trip from Oceankaj to Tivoli cost approx. DKK 200.00 – DKK 250.00 depending on time of the day.

Buses - There are several bus lines to and from the centre of Copenhagen. Copenhagen Airport also provides free terminal bus service, which runs between the terminals around the clock.

Buses

Trains (about 20 min) - Regional and intercity trains link the airport with Denmark and southern Sweden. The ticket office is located in Terminal 3, immediately above the railway station. Train and metro tickets can be purchased at the DSB ticket office in Terminal 3. You can also buy various types of tickets for the metropolitan area at the designated ticket machines.

Metro (about 15 minutes) - The metro station is located in extension of Terminal 3. The Metro runs at 4–6 minute intervals during the day and evening hours and at 15–20 minute intervals at night. The metro station is located in a covered, direct extension of Terminal 3. The Metro runs at 4–6 minute intervals during the day and evening hours, at 15–20 minute intervals at night. It takes 15 minutes from Nørreport Station to the airport by metro. Tickets for the Metro can be purchased at the station and at DSB's ticket office in Terminal 3. Please note that the ticket machines do not accept notes, only coins and credit cards such as Dankort, VISA, etc.
